Privacy Policy

Introduction

Your privacy is important to Unimarket™ Holdings Ltd (herewith referred to as "Unimarket"). This privacy statement provides information about the personal information that Unimarket collects, and the ways in which Unimarket uses that personal information.

By accepting the Privacy Policy and the associated User Agreement, you expressly consent to our collection, storage, use and disclosure of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy. The terms of this Agreement are effective from October 1st, 2008.

Personal information collection

Unimarket may collect and use the following kinds of personal information:

- Information that you provide for the purpose of registering with the website including email address, physical contact information, and (depending on the service used) sometimes financial information, such as credit card or bank account numbers.
- Information about transactions carried out over this website including bidding, buying, selling, item and content you generate or that relates to your account.
- Information about your use of this website including computer sign-on data, statistics on page views, traffic to and from the Site, and ad data: other information, including IP address and standard web log information.
- Supplemental information from third parties. (For example, if you incur a debt to Unimarket, we will generally conduct a credit check by obtaining additional information about you from a credit bureau, as permitted by law. As another example, if the information you provide cannot be verified, we may ask you to send us additional information (such as your driver license, credit card statement, and/or a recent utility bill or other information confirming your address), or to answer additional questions online to help verify your information.)
- Information regarding membership in user groups and communities within Unimarket™ ; community discussions, chats, dispute resolution, correspondence through the Site, and correspondence sent direct to Unimarket.

Using personal information

Unimarket may use your personal information to:

- Provide services and customer support as requested by you.
- Resolve disputes, collect fees, and troubleshoot problems.
- Prevent potentially prohibited or illegal activities, and enforce our User Agreement.
- Customize, measure, and improve Unimarket content, layout and services.
- Advise you of targeted marketing, service updates, and promotional offers based on your communication preferences; and compare information for accuracy verifying it with third parties.

Unimarket will not sell or rent your personal information to third parties for their marketing purposes without your explicit consent. Where Unimarket discloses your personal information to its agents or sub-contractors, the agent or sub-contractor in question will be obligated to use that personal information in accordance with the terms of this privacy statement.

You acknowledge that, by purchasing from a store within Unimarket™, you give consent for Unimarket to disclose your identity (including First Name, Last Name, Company, Email Address and Address) to that store. You acknowledge that, by accepting an invitation to join a community within Unimarket™, you give consent for Unimarket to disclose your identity & transactions through that community (including First Name, Last Name, Company, Email Address, Address and purchases) to that community.

In addition to the disclosures reasonably necessary for the purposes identified elsewhere above, Unimarket may disclose your personal information to the extent that it is required to do so by law, in connection with any legal proceedings or prospective legal proceedings, and in order to establish, exercise or defend its legal rights.

Without limiting the above, in an effort to respect your privacy and our ability to keep the community free from bad actors, we will not otherwise disclose your personal information to law enforcement, other government officials, or other third parties without a subpoena, court order or substantially similar legal procedure, except when we believe in good faith that the disclosure of information is necessary to prevent imminent physical harm or financial loss or to report suspected illegal activity.

Cookies

Unimarket uses "session cookies" meaning that they are used during an active session to improve user experience on our site. However, the cookies are not used to track users and are not actually required to access the Unimarket application.

Spam, spyware or spoofing

- Unimarket and our users do not tolerate spam. Ensure your Unimarket™ notification preferences are set so that we communicate with you as you prefer.
- You may not use our communication tools to send spam or otherwise send content that would violate our User Agreement.

Unimarket does filter and automatically scan messages before they are sent for viruses and other illegal or prohibited content but do not permanently store email messages sent through these tools. If you send an email to an email address that is not registered in our community (via Refer a Friend or other tool), we do not permanently store that email or use that email address for any marketing purpose. We do not rent or sell these email addresses.

Although we work extremely hard to protect your privacy third parties may unlawfully intercept or access transmissions or private communications, and other users may abuse or misuse your personal information that they collect from the Unimarket site. We do not promise the privacy of your personal information, and you hereby release Unimarket from any liability as it pertains to your personal information or private communications.

Cross-border data transfers
